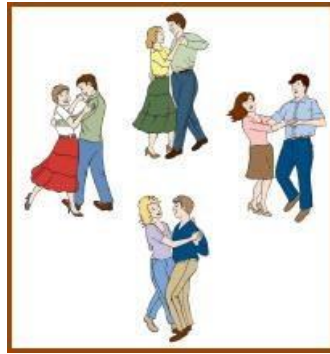

Village Squares Dance Site: Bridgman Elementary School, 9550 Tower St., Bridgman, MI	
<p>From I-94 exit 16 Go NORTH on Red Arrow Highway 1 mile Turn right (EAST) on Lake St. go 9 tenths mile. Turn left (NORTH) on Tower St. Turn left at dead end into school parking lot. School entrance is at west end of parking lot under the portico roof.</p>	<p>From Niles, MI via U.S. 31 heading NORTH <i>Take Exit 13 toward Berrien Springs, MI</i> <i>Turn RIGHT (WEST) on E. Snow Rd. go 1.2 mi.</i> <i>Turn Right (NORTH) on Red Bud Trail go 1.5 mi.</i> <i>Turn Left (WEST) on E. Shawnee Rd go 8.4 mi.</i> Turn right (NORTH) on Tower St. Turn left at dead end into school parking lot. School entrance is at west end of parking lot under the portico roof.</p>
